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Introduction

This codebook describes the *Public Use*-dataset of the AUTNES candidate survey conducted after the national parliamentary election of 29 September 2013. The dataset is based on a written census survey of the 3,946 candidates for the National Council election. Data collection lasted from November 2013 to June 2014. The fieldwork was conducted by a team of researchers at the Department of Government at the University of Vienna. The Principal Investigator of the AUTNES candidate survey 2013 is Univ.-Prof. Dr. Wolfgang C. Müller.
