**Introduction of the Euro in the New Member States**

ARCHIVE INFORMATION / ERRATA

- UNIQID: This variable excludes Cyprus, Malta and Slovenia, i.e. countries where only telephone interviews were conducted.
- IW\_LANG: One case from Poland is not assigned to a language group.
- IW\_CODE: Please notice that interviewer codes are partly or completely not available for face-to-face interviews conducted in Estonia, Hungary and Poland.
- W3 (TELEPHONE ACCESS WEIGHT): This weighting factor is only available for countries where both, telephone and face-to-face interviews were conducted.
- MODE: This variable identifies the interview mode for countries where both, telephone and face-to-face interviews were conducted. In Cyprus, Malta and Slovenia only telephone interviews were conducted (SYSMIS).
- REGION: Regions (NUTS levels 1 to 3) have been documented (labelled) in accordance with the demographic section of the respective national field questionnaire (D5) for Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania and Poland. Regions for the Czech Republic, Cyprus, Hungary, Malta, Slovenia and Slovakia were specified by using the official NUTS listings. In some cases regional information is only available for face-to-face interviews.
- D2/D3: Please notice that for several respondents the indicated "AGE WHEN STOPPED FULL-TIME EDUCATION" is too high for the actual age.
- D3/D4: Labels for codes '0' and '99' seemed to be exchanged. According to the questionnaire '0' should be STILL IN FULL TIME EDUCATION and '99' REFUSAL/NO ANSWER. At the same time almost 80% of the respondents coded '0' (n=901) are coded as "Students (full time)" in D4. The ARCHIVE has corrected the labels for D3 in accordance with the questionnaire. Nevertheless, after correcting D3 labels accordingly, still several cases that refuse to answer ('99') to D3 are coded as "Students (full time)" in D4. In addition, several cases that are coded '1' (never been in full-time education) in D3 are coded as "Students (full time)" in D4; and several respondents indicating an "Age when stopped full time education" in D3 are coded as full-time students in D4.
