**Errata Documentation**

- W3: TELEPHONE ACCESS WEIGHT - this weighting factor only includes countries where both telephone and face-to-face interviews were conducted.
- STARTH, STARTM, ENDH, ENDM, START, END, ALLCALLS, LENTIM: not available for all cases.
- REGION: For Lithuania and Poland regions have been labelled in accordance to the national field questionnaires. For other countries the regions have been specified in accordance to former Flash EB surveys and official NUTS classification (levels 1 to 3) by the ARCHIVE. For 26 cases from Belgium no region has been coded.
- Q11A/Q11B: Please notice overlaps, i.e. cases mentioning identical items on the first and the second place. This is especially true for items 1 to 3.
- D3/D4: Several cases that refuse to answer (code 0) or declare that they "never have been in full-time education" (code 1) in D3, are coded as "Students (full time)" in D4. Furthermore several respondents indicating an "Age when stopped full time education" in D3 are still "full-time students" according to D4.
- D6: Category '3' (Citizen of a non-European Union country) is only available for ESTONIA and LATVIA. Erroneous code '4' in the original data set was recoded to '3' by the ARCHIVE.
- D98A, D98B, D99A, D99B: Variables are only available for countries where both telephone AND face-to-face interviews were conducted. POLAND: D98; ESTONIA, LATVIA, LITHUANIA, HUNGARY, SLOVAKIA: D99. Data for the CZECH REPUBLIC are only available for the summarized variable FIXTEL. These variables were supposedly used for dual frame weighting (W3).
