**ARCHIVE INFORMATION AND ERRATA**

- CASE ID: Original case identification (by COUNTRY) includes 225 non-unique id numbers, but no duplicate cases. The archive appointed a unique serial id.
- IW\_LANG: Code 'XA' is not documented; supposedly referring to an extra language version for Malta (n=35).
- LENTIM: Not documented (interview length)
- REGION: Official NUTS classification in this variable has been specified by the archive in accordance with the corresponding official NUTS classification, former Flash EB waves, or the technical report.
- MODE: This variable identifies the interview mode for countries where both telephone and face-to-face interviews were conducted.
- W3: This weight only includes countries where both telephone and face-to-face interviews were conducted (DUAL FRAME WEIGHT).
- D98A, D98B, D99A, D99B: Variables are only available for countries where both telephone AND face-to-face interviews were conducted. POLAND: D98; CZECH REPUBLIC, ESTONIA, LATVIA, LITHUANIA, HUNGARY, SLOVAKIA, BULGARIA, ROMANIA: D99. These variables were supposedly used for dual frame weighting (W3).
