

THE SEPTEMBER 1965 GERMAN ELECTION STUDY
(ZENTRALARCHIV NO. 556 -- ICPR NO. 7103)

THE DATA FOR THE SEPTEMBER 1965 GERMAN ELECTION STUDY WERE ORIGINALLY COLLECTED BY MAX KAASE AND RUDOLF WILDENMANN, LEHRSTUHL FUER POLITISCHE WISSENSCHAFT, UNIVERSITY OF MANNHEIM. THE DATA WERE MADE AVAILABLE FOR ANALYSIS AS A JOINT ARCHIVAL PROJECT OF THE CONSORTIUM, THE ZENTRALARCHIV FUER EMPIRISCHE SOZIALFORSCHUNG, UNIVERSITY OF COLOGNE, AND THE ZENTRUM FUER UMFragen, METHODEN UND ANALYSEN, MANNHEIM. NEITHER THE ORIGINAL COLLECTORS OF THE DATA NOR THE CONSORTIUM BEAR ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE ANALYSES OR INTERPRETATION PRESENTED HERE.

IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FUNDING AGENCIES WITH ESSENTIAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE USE OF ARCHIVAL RESOURCES, AND TO FACILITATE THE EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION ABOUT ICPR PARTICIPANTS' RESEARCH ACTIVITIES, EACH USER OF THE ICPR DATA FACILITIES IS EXPECTED TO SEND TWO COPIES OF EACH COMPLETED MANUSCRIPT OR THESIS ABSTRACT TO THE CONSORTIUM. PLEASE INDICATE IN THE COVER LETTER WHICH DATA WERE USED.

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STUDY DESCRIPTION

THE SEPTEMBER 1965 GERMAN ELECTION STUDY WAS CONDUCTED BY MAX KAASE AND RUDOLF WILDENMANN, LEHRSTUHL FÜR POLITISCHE WISSENSCHAFTEN, UNIVERSITY OF MANNHEIM. THE FIELDWORK WAS CARRIED OUT BY DIVO-INSTITUTE, FRANKFURT (DIVO PROJECT NO. 666). ALL RESPONDENTS WERE INTERVIEWED DURING THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER AND INTERVIEWING WAS COMPLETED SEVERAL DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTION. THE STUDY INTERVIEWED 1411 RESPONDENTS AND WAS FINANCED BY THE SECOND GERMAN TELEVISION NETWORK (ZDF).

THE STUDY DEALT WITH A WIDE RANGE OF POLITICALLY RELEVANT ATTITUDES AND BEHAVIOR IN THE CONTEXT OF THE 1965 ELECTION. THE INTERVIEW INQUIRED ABOUT THE RESPONDENT'S VOTING BEHAVIOR IN THE 1961 ELECTION, HIS ANTICIPATED BEHAVIOR IN THE 1965 ELECTION, AND HIS PREFERENCES FOR THE GOVERNMENT COALITION AND CHANCELLORSHIP FOLLOWING THE ELECTION. BROADER QUESTIONS DEALT WITH THE GENERAL EXTENT OF MASS MEDIA USAGE, AND ALSO MEDIA USAGE SPECIFICALLY AS A POLITICAL NEWS SOURCE. THE RESPONDENT'S RELIANCE ON A VARIETY OF OTHER SOURCES OF POLITICAL INFORMATION WAS ALSO MEASURED, AS WELL AS HIS LEVEL OF POLITICAL INTEREST. THE INTERVIEW DETERMINED THE RESPONDENT'S PERCEPTION AS TO WHETHER THE CDU/CSU OR SPD COULD BEST DEAL WITH A SET OF ISSUES CURRENTLY FACING THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC: GERMAN REUNIFICATION, FOREIGN RELATIONS WITH THE EAST AND WEST, ECONOMIC POLICY, EDUCATIONAL POLICY, AND OTHER FOREIGN AND DOMESTIC ISSUES. THE PROCEDURE WAS REPEATED AS THE RESPONDENT WAS ASKED WHETHER BRANDT OR ERHARD COULD BEST DEAL WITH A SIMILAR LIST OF ISSUES. THE SURVEY ALSO INCLUDED SCALOMETERS WHICH WERE USED IN EVALUATING THE MAJOR POLITICAL FIGURES OF 1965. SCALOMETERS WERE ALSO USED TO EVALUATE THE POLITICAL PARTIES, AND FURTHER QUESTIONS INQUIRED ABOUT RECENT CHANGES IN PARTY EVALUATIONS. ANOTHER SERIES OF QUESTIONS ASSESSED THE PERCEIVED POLITICAL INFLUENCE OF THE PROTESTANT AND CATHOLIC CHURCHES, LABOR UNIONS, THE FARMERS' ASSOCIATION, AND THE EMPLOYERS' ASSOCIATION.

THE PERSONAL DATA SECTION OF THE INTERVIEW OBTAINED INFORMATION ABOUT THE EDUCATION, OCCUPATION, RELIGIOUS PREFERENCE, MARITAL STATUS, AGE, SEX, AND VOLUNTARY ASSOCIATIONAL MEMBERSHIPS OF THE RESPONDENT. THIS SECTION ALSO OBTAINED THE OCCUPATION AND INCOME OF THE HEAD OF THE HOUSEHOLD.

SAMPLING INFORMATION

THE UNIVERSE SAMPLED IN THIS STUDY CONSISTS OF VOTING AGE CITIZENS OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, EXCLUDING WEST BERLIN, WHO LIVE IN PRIVATE HOUSEHOLDS AND ARE REGISTERED IN THE COMMUNITY CENTRAL REGISTRY OF INHABITANTS ("EINWOHNERMELDEKARTEI"). THIS EXCLUDES PERSONS LIVING IN GROUP QUARTERS, INSTITUTIONAL POPULATIONS, AND PERSONS WITH NO PLACE OF RESIDENCE.

THE STUDY UTILIZED A STRATIFIED, MULTISTAGE, RANDOM SAMPLING PROCEDURE. THERE WERE THREE STAGES OF SAMPLING. FIRST, SELECTION OF THE SAMPLING POINTS; THEN HOUSEHOLDS WERE SELECTED WITHIN EACH SAMPLING POINT; FINALLY, INDIVIDUALS WERE SELECTED WITHIN EACH HOUSEHOLD.

STAGE 1: THE FIRST STAGE CONSISTED OF THE SELECTION OF SAMPLING POINTS FROM A COMPLETE LIST OF ALL COMMUNITIES ("GEMEINDE") IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC. ALL COMMUNITIES WERE FIRST DIVIDED INTO TWO STRATA: STRATUM 1 INCLUDED ALL COMMUNITIES WITH LESS THAN 2,000 INHABITANTS, STRATUM 2 CONTAINED ALL COMMUNITIES OF 2,000 OR MORE INHABITANTS. AN ADDITIONAL STRATIFICATION WAS MADE TO OBTAIN A REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLE FOR EACH STATE ("BUNDESLAND"), AS WELL AS FOR THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC AS A WHOLE.

THE SELECTION OF SAMPLING POINTS FROM STRATUM 1 TOOK PLACE IN TWO STEPS. BEGINNING IN THE NORTH OF GERMANY AND GRADUALLY MOVING SOUTH WITHIN EACH STATE, COMMUNITIES IN STRATUM 1 WERE GROUPED TOGETHER UNTIL THE TOTAL POPULATION OF THE GROUP -- OR CELL -- EXCEEDED A SPECIFIED LIMIT. FROM EACH CELL A COUNTY ("KREIS") WAS RANDOMLY SELECTED. COMMUNITIES WERE SYSTEMATICALLY ADDED FROM IMMEDIATELY SOUTH OF THE COUNTY, OR SUBTRACTED FROM THE NORTH OF THE COUNTY UNTIL AN AREA CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY ONE QUARTER OF THE TOTAL CELL POPULATION WAS DEFINED. IN THE SECOND STEP ALL COMMUNITIES FROM AN AREA DESIGNATED IN STEP ONE WERE LISTED IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER. A CUMULATIVE TOTAL OF COMMUNITY POPULATIONS WAS COMPUTED. THEN, TWO RANDOM NUMBERS WERE OBTAINED, AND A COMMUNITY WHOSE CUMULATIVE TOTAL ENCOMPASSED A NUMBER WAS SELECTED AS A SAMPLING POINT. THUS THE PROBABILITY OF ANY STRATUM 1 COMMUNITY BEING SELECTED WAS PROPORTIONAL TO ITS POPULATION SIZE.

A SOMEWHAT DIFFERENT PROCEDURE WAS USED IN SELECTING STRATUM 2 SAMPLING POINTS. WITHIN EACH STATE THE LARGER COMMUNITIES WERE GROUPED INTO SEVERAL CATEGORIES -- OR SUBSTRATA -- BASED ON THEIR POPULATION SIZE. THE NUMBER OF SAMPLING POINTS TO BE SELECTED FROM EACH SUBSTRATUM WAS PROPORTIONAL TO THE SUBSTRATUM'S POPULATION RELATIVE TO THE TOTAL STRATUM 2 POPULATION IN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC. COMMUNITIES WITHIN EACH SUBSTRATUM WERE PLACED IN ALPHABETICAL ORDER AND THEIR POPULATION TOTALS CUMULATED. A SET OF RANDOM NUMBERS EQUAL TO THE DESIRED NUMBER OF SAMPLING POINTS WERE OBTAINED. A COMMUNITY WHOSE CUMULATIVE TOTAL ENCOMPASSED ONE OF THESE RANDOM NUMBERS WAS SELECTED AS A SAMPLING POINT. THIS PROCEDURE MADE THE PROBABILITY OF SELECTION PROPORTIONAL TO THE SIZE OF THE COMMUNITY WITH THE POSSIBILITY OF MULTIPLE SELECTION OF THE SAME COMMUNITY.

STAGE 2: WHEN THE COMMUNITIES OF THE SAMPLE HAD BEEN DETERMINED, THE HOUSEHOLDS TO BE CONTACTED WERE SYSTEMATICALLY SELECTED FROM A CENTRAL REGISTRY OF INHABITANTS ("EINWOHNERMELDEKARTEI") IN EACH COMMUNITY. THE PROCEDURE PRODUCED A LIST OF HOUSEHOLDS FOR THE SAMPLE.

STAGE 3: IN EACH SELECTED HOUSEHOLD ALL MEMBERS OVER AGE 21 WERE LISTED IN A FIXED ORDER BY AGE AND SEX. A RESPONDENT WAS THEN SELECTED FROM EACH HOUSEHOLD LIST USING A RANDOM NUMBER TABLE, WITHOUT THE POSSIBILITY OF SUBSTITUTION. A TOTAL OF 1411 RESPONDENTS WERE INTERVIEWED.

THE SAMPLING, FIELDWORK, AND CODING FOR THE STUDY WAS CONDUCTED BY DIVO-INSTITUTE, FRANKFURT.

WEIGHTING INFORMATION

THIS STUDY CONTAINS A WEIGHT VARIABLE (V3) WHICH PRODUCES A REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLE OF THE VOTING AGE CITIZENS OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC WHEN USED IN ANALYSIS. THE WEIGHT VARIABLE CORRECTS FOR SEX AND AGE BIASES OF THE SAMPLE, AND WAS CONSTRUCTED BY COMPARING THE AGE BY SEX DISTRIBUTION OF RESPONDENTS IN THIS STUDY WITH THE COMPARABLE CENSUS DISTRIBUTION. THESE WEIGHTS REPLACE THE ORIGINAL DIVO INSTITUTE WEIGHTS WHICH WERE CONSTRUCTED ON THE BASIS OF SLIGHTLY DIFFERENT CRITERIA.

THE UNWEIGHTED N FOR THIS SAMPLE = 1411, THE WEIGHTED N OF THE SAMPLE = 1407.8. ALL RESPONDENTS WERE GIVEN WEIGHT VALUES TO ONE IMPLIED DECIMAL PLACE ON THE BASIS OF THE FOLLOWING TABLE:

FREQUENCIES

THE FREQUENCIES IN THE BODY OF THE CODEBOOK REFLECT THE USE OF THE DECIMAL WEIGHTS (V3) AND HAVE BEEN ROUNDED UP TO THE NEXT INTEGER BEFORE INSERTION INTO THE CODEBOOK. CONSEQUENTLY, THE FREQUENCIES SUBJECTED TO ROUNDING DO NOT ALWAYS ADD UP TO THE EXPECTED N.

CODEBOOK INFORMATION

THE EXAMPLE BELOW IS A REPRODUCTION (NOT ACTUAL SIZE) OF INFORMATION APPEARING IN THE MACHINE-READABLE CODEBOOK FOR A TYPICAL VARIABLE. THE NUMBERS IN CIRCLES DO NOT APPEAR IN THE CODEBOOK, BUT ARE REFERENCES TO THE DESCRIPTIONS WHICH FOLLOW THIS EXAMPLE

1. INDICATES THE VARIABLE AND REFERENCE NUMBERS. A VARIABLE AND A REFERENCE NUMBER ARE ASSIGNED TO EACH ITEM IN THE STUDY. IN THE PRESENT CODEBOOK, WHICH DOCUMENTS THE ARCHIVED DATASET, THESE NUMBERS ARE IDENTICAL. SHOULD THE DATA BE SUBSETTED OR REARRANGED BY AN OSIRIS PROGRAM (E.G., MMP TO INTERSPERSE DATA FROM ANOTHER SOURCE, OR TCOT TO PRODUCE AN ANALYSIS DECK), THE VARIABLE NUMBERS WOULD CHANGE TO REFLECT THE ORDER OF THE NEW DATASET, WHILE THE REFERENCE NUMBERS WOULD REMAIN UNCHANGED TO REFLECT THE VARIABLE NUMBER IN THE CODEBOOK DESCRIBING THE ARCHIVED DATASET.

2. INDICATES THE FOUR COLUMN ICPR STUDY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER UNIQUE TO THIS DATASET.
3. INDICATES THE ABBREVIATED (24 CHARACTERS MAXIMUM) VARIABLE NAME USED WITHIN THE OSIRIS SYSTEM TO IDENTIFY THE VARIABLE FOR THE USER. AN EXPANDED VERSION OF THESE NAMES CAN BE FOUND IN THE CONTENTS SECTION.
4. INDICATES THE DESIGNATION OF MISSING DATA. IN THIS EXAMPLE CODE VALUES GREATER OR EQUAL TO NINETY-SEVEN ARE MISSING DATA (MD=GE 97). ALTERNATIVE STATEMENTS FOR OTHER VARIABLES ARE OF THE FORM "MD=9", "MD=0 OR GE 8", OR "NO MISSING DATA CODES". SOME ANALYSIS SOFTWARE PACKAGES (OSIRIS SOFTWARE PACKAGE), REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN TYPES OF DATA WHICH THE USER DESIRES TO EXCLUDE FROM ANALYSIS BE DESIGNATED AS "MISSING DATA", E.G. INAPPROPRIATE, NOT ASCERTAINED, OR AMBIGUOUS DATA CATEGORIES. ALTHOUGH THESE CATEGORIES ARE DEFINED AS MISSING DATA CATEGORIES, THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT A USER SHOULD NOT OR CANNOT USE THESE CODES IN A SUBSTANTIVE ROLE IF HE SO DESIRES.
5. A MULTIPLE RESPONSE VARIABLE IS DENOTED BY THE MESSAGE, "MULT RESPS X", WHERE X IS THE NUMBER OF RESPONSES.
6. INDICATES THE STARTING LOCATION AND WIDTH OF THIS VARIABLE WHEN THE DATA ARE STORED ON A MAGNETIC TAPE IN THE OSIRIS FORMAT. THESE LOCATIONS MAY ALSO BE USED TO ACCESS THE DATA WITH SOFTWARE PACKAGES WHICH DO NOT USE THE OSIRIS DICTIONARY.
7. INDICATES THE LOCATION BY DECK AND COLUMN(S) OF THIS VARIABLE WHEN THE DATA ARE ON CARDS OR IN CARD IMAGE FORM (EITHER 80 OR 84 COLUMN FORMAT).
8. A VARIABLE CONTAINING DATA WITH IMPLIED DECIMALS IS DENOTED BY THE MESSAGE "XX DEC PLACE(S)", WHERE XX IS THE NUMBER OF DECIMAL PLACES IMPLIED (NOT PUNCHED) IN THE VARIABLE.
9. INDICATES THE FULL (QUESTION) TEXT SUPPLIED BY THE INVESTIGATOR TO DESCRIBE THE VARIABLE. PHRASES ENCLOSED IN (" AND ") USUALLY DENOTE GERMAN LANGUAGE TERMS WHICH HAVE A FURTHER DESCRIPTION IN THE GLOSSARY INCLUDED IN THIS CODEBOOK.

10. INDICATES AN ADDITIONAL COMMENT OR EXPLANATION APPENDED TO THE VARIABLE DESCRIPTION OR CODER INSTRUCTIONS.
11. A VARIABLE WHICH HAS A FOOTNOTE ASSOCIATED WITH IT IS DENOTED BY THE MESSAGE, "SEE NOTE(S) X", WHERE X IS THE NUMBER OF THE FOOTNOTE REFERENCED.
12. INDICATES THE FREQUENCY OF OCCURRENCE OF EACH CODE VALUE. FREQUENCIES FOR MULTIPLE RESPONSE VARIABLES ARE CUMULATIVE.
13. INDICATES THE CODE VALUES OCCURRING IN THE DATA FOR THIS VARIABLE.
14. INDICATES THE TEXTUAL DEFINITIONS OF THE CODES.

DATA PREPARATION AND FORMATTING

THE SEPTEMBER 1965 GERMAN ELECTION STUDY WAS MADE AVAILABLE FOR ANALYSIS AS A JOINT ARCHIVAL PROJECT OF THE ICPR, THE ZENTRALARCHIV FUER EMPIRISCHE SOZIALFORSCHUNG, UNIVERSITY OF COLOGNE, AND THE ZENTRUM FUER UMFRAGEN, METHODEN UND ANALYSEN, MANNHEIM. WE ACKNOWLEDGE THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF THE CONFERENCE GROUP ON GERMAN POLITICS IN SUPPORT OF THE TRANSLATION AND PREPARATION OF THE DOCUMENTATION. THE DATA PROCESSING AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF OSIRIS DATASETS AND DOCUMENTATION WAS DONE AT THE ZENTRALARCHIV. A GERMAN LANGUAGE Z.A.R. CODEBOOK CONTAINING A STUDY DESCRIPTION, TECHNICAL INFORMATION, AND VARIABLE DOCUMENTATION PARALLELLING THE OSIRIS CARD IMAGE DATASET IS AVAILABLE FROM THE ZENTRALARCHIV FUER EMPIRISCHE SOZIALFORSCHUNG, UNIVERSITY OF COLOGNE, D-5000 COLOGNE 41, BACHEMER STRASSE 40, WEST GERMANY.

THE DATA RECEIVED BY THE ARCHIVE WERE FIRST SORTED AND CHECKED FOR MISSING OR DUPLICATE CARDS. DUPLICATE CARDS WERE VERIFIED, THEN THE DUPLICATES WERE REMOVED. MISSING CARDS WERE REPLACED BY MISSING DATA VALUES. THE DATA WERE THEN CHECKED FOR ILLEGAL (WILD) CODES AND INCONSISTENCIES WHICH, WHENEVER FOUND WERE ASSIGNED TO MISSING DATA VALUES. THE CODEBOOK WAS REORDERED TO PRESERVE THE ORDER OF THE ORIGINAL QUESTIONNAIRE. INDICES WERE INCLUDED AS CREATED BY THE ORIGINAL INVESTIGATORS. THROUGHOUT THE TEXT ADDITIONAL COMMENTS BRACKETED IN < AND > SIGNS, WERE INSERTED BY THE STUDY PROCESSOR IN THE COURSE OF PREPARING THE CODEBOOK IN ORDER TO FACILITATE NON-SEQUENTIAL REFERENCING AND TO PROVIDE FURTHER EXPLANATORY INFORMATION.

THE DATA ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE CONSORTIUM IN TWO FORMATS: A CARD IMAGE FILE, OR AN OSIRIS DATASET. THE CARD IMAGE FILE CONTAINS 2 DECKS PER RESPONDENT IN A FORMAT BASED ON 80 COLUMN PUNCHED CARDS. THE DECKS FOR EACH RESPONDENT ARE SORTED IN ASCENDING ORDER. THERE ARE TWO COMPONENTS TO THE OSIRIS DATASET. THE OSIRIS DICTIONARY GIVES THE FORMAT AND OTHER INFORMATION FOR EACH VARIABLE IN THE OSIRIS DATA FILE. THE DICTIONARY OR DICTIONARY-CODEBOOK IS USED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE OSIRIS SOFTWARE PACKAGE. THE OSIRIS DATA FILE IS CONSTRUCTED WITH A SINGLE LOGICAL RECORD PER RESPONDENT. THE OSIRIS DATA FILE CAN BE ACCESSED DIRECTLY BY SOFTWARE PACKAGES WHICH DO NOT USE THE OSIRIS DICTIONARY BY SPECIFYING THE TAPE LOCATIONS OF THE DESIRED VARIABLES. THESE TAPE LOCATIONS ARE CONTAINED IN THE OSIRIS CODEBOOK.

THE QUESTIONNAIRE WAS TRANSLATED FROM GERMAN BY KAI HILDEBRANDT, ICPR. THE TRANSLATION ATTEMPTS TO RETAIN AS MUCH OF THE LITERAL PHRASING AS POSSIBLE, EXCEPT IN INSTANCES WHERE THE MEANING WOULD BE UNCLEAR IF PHRASING WERE NOT CHANGED. IN A FEW INSTANCES TERMS IN THE ORIGINAL LANGUAGE ENCLOSED IN (" AND ") WERE INCLUDED AS AN INDICATOR OF A CLEARER SENSE OF THE TEXT. THE MORE ESSENTIAL OF THESE GERMAN TERMS ARE DESCRIBED IN THE GLOSSARY CONTAINED IN THIS CODEBOOK.
