Included in the 2011 KGSS, besides ISSP, are the special topical modules <Citizenship, Altruism and Donation in Korea>, < Ageism in Korea > and <Diffusion of Human Rights Consciousness in Korea>. The ISSP standard background variables are incorporated into the replicating core questionnaires section of the KGSS. In the 2011 KGSS, all ISSP variables(both topical and background) have been included.
