ARCHIVE INFORMATION AND ERRATA

- **SURVEY:** The survey is divided in two parts, one for DG ENTERPRISE (271) surveyed in all countries and one for the European Central Bank (ECB) surveyed in France, Germany, the Netherlands, Italy, Spain and Portugal only. Accordingly and as indicated in the basic questionnaire, the survey contains COMMON questions and questions asked to ENTR or to ECB respondents only.
Please notice the questions Q5, Q6 and Q23 are indicated as ECB in the basic questionnaire, but do include data from both survey parts (ENTR+ECB).
- **WEIGHTING:** Three sets of weighting factors are supplied, one for the analysis Flash 271 data (ENTR or COMMON questions), one for the COMMON part (ENTR+ECB), and a reduced set of weighting factors for the ECB data (no EU weights).
