#### ARCHIVE INFORMATION AND ERRATA

- CASEID / UNIQID: The original case identification numbers (CASEID) are not unique within each country. ID numbers '49' for SPAIN and '174' for Portugal are duplicates. For SPAIN the complete case is a duplicate (UNIQID '1743' and '1748'). The unique serial case identification for the complete data set (UNIQID) has been appointed by the archive.
- WSAMPLE: For *post-stratification weighting* a comparison between the sample and the universe was carried out country by country, except for BELGIUM, ITALY, LUXEMBOURG, IRELAND, GREECE and SPAIN (factor=1). WSAMPLE is supposed to be applied whenever countries are analyzed separately, e.g. to compare results for one country to results for another country.  
Please notice that at least for three countries the representativeness of the respective sample is limited: GREECE: the 5 main urban areas; Ireland: the Dublin area; Portugal: the 4 main urban areas.
- WEU12: The *population size weights* correct for the fact that countries have almost identical sample sizes, no matter how large or small their populations are. They ensure that each country is represented in proportion to its population size when the group of all countries (EU12) is the object of study. The WSAMPLE factors are included.
- REGION: Please notice that data set categories have COUNTRY SPECIFIC meanings as documented in the corresponding code sheet (see: ZA2875\_bq.pdf). In the data set code sheet category '0' is coded '10', 'X' is coded '11' and 'Y' is coded '12'. The documentation for PORTUGAL is not clear. The code sheet states 12 categories while only ten categories ('1' to '10') are coded in the data set.
