# THE COMMUNISM, CONFORMITY, AND CIVIL LIBERTIES STUDY CROSS-SECTION SAMPLE

(ICPR STUDY NUMBER 7202)

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#### STUDY DESCRIPTION

THE "COMMUNISM, CONFORMITY, AND CIVIL LIBERTIES" STUDY (PREVIOUSLY RELEASED BY ICPR AS THE "STOUFFER STUDY") WAS CONDUCTED BY THE AMERICAN INSTITUTE OF PUBLIC OPINION AND THE NATIONAL OPINION RESEARCH CENTER IN 1954. THE STUDY EXAMINES AMERICANS' PERCEPTIONS OF THE THREAT OF A COMMUNIST CONSPIRACY BOTH WITHIN THE UNITED STATES AND OUTSIDE THE UNITED STATES. IN ADDITION, THE SURVEY EXPLORES THE POTENTIAL FOR THE CURTAILMENT OF CIVIL LIBERTIES BY THOSE WHO WOULD THWART THE CONSPIRACY. THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS ARE AMONG THOSE INVESTIGATED IN THE STUDY: ARE CIVIC LEADERS MORE TOLERANT THAN AVERAGE CITIZENS? DO AMERICANS VIEW THE CONGRESSIONAL INVESTIGATING COMMITTEES FAVORABLY OR UNFAVORABLY? ARE AMERICANS ANXIOUS ABOUT A COMMUNIST CONSPIRACY?

THE QUESTIONNAIRE BEGINS WITH OPEN-ENDED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE WORRIES AND PROBLEMS OF THE RESPONDENT, FOLLOWED BY QUESTIONS ABOUT HIS/HER OPINIONS ON COMMUNISM. PERSONAL DATA OBTAINED INCLUDES THE RESPONDENT'S AGE, SEX, RACE, MARITAL STATUS, AND OCCUPATION.

SURVEY RESULTS HAVE BEEN PUBLISHED IN COMMUNISM, CONFORMITY, AND CIVIL LIBERTIES, SAMUEL A. STOUFFER, DOUBLEDAY AND COMPANY, INC., GARDEN CITY, NEW YORK, 1955.

#### SAMPLING INFORMATION

THE SURVEY WAS MADE IN MAY, JUNE, AND JULY OF 1954. STAFF OF EACH AGENCY WORKED INDEPENDENTLY TO CONSTRUCT REPRESENTATIVE SAMPLES OF THE AMERICAN POPULATION. BOTH AGENCIES EMPLOYED THE PROBABILITY METHOD OF SAMPLING. TWO SUB-SAMPLES COMPOSE THE STOUFFER SURVEY: THE NATIONAL CROSS SECTION SAMPLE OF 4933 RESPONDENTS, AND A SPECIAL LEADERSHIP SAMPLE OF 1500 SELECTED LOCAL COMMUNITY LEADERS. HOUSEHOLDS FOR THE CROSS-SECTION WERE CHOSEN BY USING MULTISTAGE PROB-ABILITY SAMPLING. FIRST, A SAMPLE OF COUNTIES AND METROPOL-ITAN AREAS WAS DRAWN AT RANDOM FROM A LIST OF ALL THAT EXISTED IN THE U.S. IN 1954. FROM THESE COUNTIES AND METRO-POLITAN AREAS, URBAN BLOCKS AND RURAL SEGMENTS WERE CHOSEN AT RANDOM. NEXT, A SAMPLE OF HOUSING UNITS WAS CHOSEN AT RANDOM FROM THE BLOCKS. FINALLY, AN ADULT IN EACH HOUSEHOLD WAS CHOSEN AS THE RESPONDENT. HE OR SHE WAS PICKED BY THE INTERVIEWER USING A FIXED SET OF RULES. THESE RULES AVOIDED ANY INTERVIEWER BIAS. ONCE AN ADULT WAS CHOSEN AS THE RESPONDENT, NO SUBSTITUTIONS COULD BE MADE.

#### CODEBOOK AND PROCESSING INFORMATION

THIS STUDY WAS PROCESSED ACCORDING TO ICPR STANDARD PROCESSING PROCEDURES. THE DATA WERE CHECKED FOR INCONSISTENT AND ILLEGAL CODES.

THIS CODEBOOK DOCUMENTS THE DATA GATHERED IN THE CROSS SECTION SAMPLE. IN USING IT, SEVERAL FEATURES DESERVE ATTEN-

TION. AN 'X' APPEARING BEFORE A VARIABLE NAME INDICATES THAT THE ANSWER TO THIS QUESTION IS CONTINGENT UPON THE ANSWER TO PREVIOUS QUESTIONS. EACH VARIABLE IS GIVEN A "VARIABLE NUMBER" AND A "REFERENCE NUMBER," WHICH IN THIS CODEBOOK ARE IDENTICAL. ALSO, NOTE THAT FREQUENCIES FOR MULTIPLE RESPONSE VARIABLES ARE CUMULATIVE.

THE EXAMPLE BELOW IS A REPRODUCTION (NOT ACTUAL SIZE) OF INFORMATION APPEARING IN THE MACHINE READABLE CODEBOOK FOR A TYPICAL VARIABLE. THE NUMBERS IN CIRCLES DO NOT APPEAR IN THE CODEBOOK, BUT ARE REFERENCES TO THE DESCRIPTIONS WHICH FOLLOW THIS EXAMPLE.

SHOULD THE DATA BE SUBSET OR REARRANGED BY AN OSIRIS PROGRAM (E.G., MMP TO INTERSPERSE DATA FROM ANOTHER SOURCE, OR TCOT TO PRODUCE AN ANALYSIS DECK), THE VARIABLE NUMBERS WOULD CHANGE TO REFLECT THE ORDER OF THE NEW DATASET, WHILE THE REFERENCE NUMBERS WOULD REMAIN UNCHANGED TO REFLECT THE VARIABLE NUMBER IN THE CODEBOOK DESCRIBING THE ARCHIVED DATASET.
- 2. INDICATES THE FOUR COLUMN ICPR STUDY IDENTIFICATION NUMBER UNIQUE TO THIS DATASET.
- 3. INDICATES THE ABBREVIATED (24 CHARACTERS MAXIMUM) VARI-ABLE NAME USED WITHIN THE OSIRIS SYSTEM TO IDENTIFY THE VARIABLE FOR THE USER. AN EXPANDED VERSION OT THESE NAMES CAN BE FOUND IN THE TABLE OF CONTENTS, WHERE AN 'X' PRECEDES THE NAME OF ANY VARIABLE THAT IS CONTIN-GENT ON ANOTHER VARIABLE (DUE TO THE STRUCTURE OF THE INTERVIEW SCHEDULE). "C" REFERS TO CROSS-SECTION DATA.

- 4. INDICATES THE DESIGNATION OF MISSING DATA. IN THIS EXAMPLE CODE VALUES GREATER THAN OR EQUAL TO NINE ARE MISSING DATA (MD=GE 9). ALTERNATIVE STATEMENTS FOR OTHER VARIABLES ARE OF THE FORM "MD=9," "MD=0 OR GE 9," OR "NO MISSING DATA CODES." SOME ANALYSIS SOFTWARE PACKAGES (INCLUDING THE OSIRIS SOFTWARE PACKAGE) REQUIRE THAT CERTAIN TYPES OF DATA WHICH THE USER DESIRES TO EXCLUDE FROM ANALYSIS BE DESIGNATED AS "MISSING DATA," E.G., INAPPROPRIATE, NOT ASCERTAINED, UNASCERTAINABLE, OR AMBIGUOUS DATA CATEGORIES. ALTHOUGH THESE CATEGORIES ARE DECLARED AS MISSING DATA CATEGORIES, THIS DOES NOT MEAN THAT A USER SHOULD NOT OR CANNOT USE THESE CODES IN A SUBSTANTIVE ROLE IF HE SO DESIRES.
- 5. A MULTIPLE RESPONSE VARIABLE IS DENOTED BY THE MESSAGE, "MULT RESPS X," WHERE X IS THE NUMBER OF RESPONSES.
- 6. INDICATES THE STARTING LOCATION AND WIDTH OF THIS VARIABLE WHEN THE DATA ARE STORED ON A MAGNETIC TAPE IN THE OSIRIS FORMAT. IF THE VARIABLE IS A MULTIPLE RESPONSE TYPE (AS IN THE EXAMPLE ABOVE), THE LOCATION AND WIDTH ALLUDE TO THE FIRST RESPONSE CODED.
- 7. INDICATES THE LOCATION BY DECK AND COLUMN(S) OF THIS VARIABLE WHEN THE DATA ARE ON CARDS OR IN CARD IMAGE FORM (EITHER 50 OR 84 COLUMN FORMAT).

- 9. INDICATES THE FULL TEXT (QUESTION) SUPPLIED BY THE INVESTIGATOR TO DESCRIBE THE VARIABLE.
- 10. INDICATES THE PLACEMENT OF AN ADDITIONAL COMMENT OR EXPLANATION APPENDED TO THE VARIABLE DESCRIPTION, WHEN APPROPRIATE.
- 11. A VARIABLE WHICH HAS A FOOTNOTE ASSOCIATED WITH IT IS DENOTED BY THE MESSAGE, "SEE NOTE(S) X," WHERE X IS THE NUMBER OF THE FOOTNOTE REFERENCED.
- 12. INDICATES THE FREQUENCY OF OCCURRENCE OF EACH CODE VALUE. FREQUENCIES FOR MULTIPLE RESPONSE VARIABLES ARE CUMULATIVE.
- 13. INDICATES THE CODE VALUES OCCURRING IN THE DATA FOR THIS VARIABLE.
- 14. INDICATES THE TEXTUAL DEFINITIONS OF THE CODES.
