This is a European Union D.G.X (Public Opinion Analysis Unit) Flash Eurobarometer, conducted by EOS GALLUP EUROPE on behalf of the European Union - D.G.XV.

The interviews have been realized by telephone during the month of April 1999, by the specialized interviewers of fifteen national Institutes working in their Country exclusively. This total interview decentralization is allowed by the network of EOS GALLUP EUROPE Institutes, namely :

The interviews have been realized by telephone, with utilization of a specific software for the contacts and questionnaires management (CATI system).

Each national sample is representative of the continental population aged 15 and over, interviewed by telephone, within the following limits :

- United Kingdom : Northern Ireland excluded

The sample sizes amount to 500 respondents in each Country, with the exception of Germany, where the sample has been set at 1000 respondents in total : 500 in each of the two formerly independent parts of the country.
