Documentation of Questionnaire

The German Longitudinal Election Study (GLES) is a long-term project funded by the German Research Foundation (Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft) which started with the 2009 federal election and is continued with the 2013 federal election. GLES is the largest and most ambitious election study held so far in Germany.

The study is directed by five principal investigators: Prof. Dr. Hans Rattinger (University of Mannheim), Prof. Dr. Sigrid Roßteutscher (Goethe-University of Frankfurt am Main), Prof. Dr. Rüdiger Schmitt-Beck (University of Mannheim), Prof. Dr. Bernhard Weißels (Social Science Research Center Berlin) and Prof. Dr. Christof Wolf (GESIS – Leibniz Institute for the Social Sciences), in close cooperation with the German Society for Electoral Studies (Deutsche Gesellschaft für Wahlforschung).

The following documentation refers to the Pre-election Cross Section (ZA5700) of the GLES 2013 and will give you some general information about the dataset.

Content	<p>The first component of GLES composes a pre- and a post-election cross-section survey. All in all, 3,911 interviews were realized (pre-election 2,003, post-election 1,908). This document relates to the pre-election cross-section survey.</p> <p>The cross-sectional data also represents the second wave of a long-term panel (first wave in 2009) in the course of which the same respondents will be surveyed again in the following two federal elections in Germany. 47 percent of the respondents in West Germany and 36 percent of the respondents in East Germany agreed to participate in the long-term panel.</p>

Methodology

Geographic Coverage	Germany (DE)
Universe	The population comprises all persons with German citizenship resident in the Federal Republic of Germany, who had a minimum age of 16 years and lived in private households at the time the survey was being conducted.
Selection Method	Disproportional stratified multistage random sampling based on the ADM-design. All in all, 210 sampling points were drawn in West Germany with the aim to realize 1,400 interviews. 96 sampling points were drawn in East Germany to realize 700 interviews. As a result of this procedure, the East German population is overrepresented in the sample. The target person in the household was determined by Kish-Selection-Grid.
Mode of Data Collection	Computer Assisted Personal Interview (CAPI) with an average duration of approximately 66 minutes (arithmetic mean).

Field Work	<p>All in all, 306 sampling points were drawn. Interviews were realized in 290 sampling points. On average, 6.5 interviews per point were realized.</p> <p>The interviewers were compensated based on the number of completed interviews, the number of documented contacts without any interview, and their travel expenses. At the end of the field work, the compensation for realized interviews and documented contacts without any interview was raised.</p> <p>All realized interviews were checked via contacting the respondents. As far as possible, the checking should have been done by telephone calls. All interviews, to which the telephone number was not available or contact via telephone was unsuccessful, were contacted by letter. If doubts about the proper realization of the interview could not be cleared up, the respective interviews were deleted from the dataset. 37 interviews were affected by this. Another 17 interviews were deleted due to abnormalities in the dataset. Furthermore, seven interviews of an entire point were not incorporated, because they were not listed in the predefined addresses. Additionally, one interview of an interviewer was not realized at the predefined address, so that this interview was also deleted from the dataset.</p>
Response rate	<p>18.4 percent of 7,650 addresses were losses not specific to the sample. Based on the adjusted 6,240 gross addresses, 2,003 interviews were realized successfully (1,303 West, 700 East). Thus, the response rate is 32.1 percent.</p>
Weights	<p>The pre-election cross section comprises three types of weights: a design weight, a transformation weight, and post-stratification weights.</p> <p>The design weight (w_{ow}) corrects for the oversampling in East Germany.</p> <p>The transformation weight (w_{tran}) transforms the data from a household sample into a personal sample.</p> <p>To ease working with both weights (East-West and transformation weight) at the same time, the “Combination Transformation and East-West weighting” (w_{trow}) was created. In order to do this, the dataset was first weighted with the transformation weight, and in a second step, the East-West weight was calculated again.</p> <p>The post-stratification weights include sociodemographic and regional weights with (and without) transformation weight. Those weights were calculated by using the iterative proportional fitting (IPF). The iteration process ends when the difference between the weighted marginal distribution and the aimed distribution becomes smaller than 0.0001. To prevent large weights, the weights were trimmed (after each iteration) so that no weight is more than five times larger than the average weight. The weights were constructed on the basis of gender, age (four groups: 16 to 29, 30 to 45, 45 to 59 and 60 years and older), education (three groups: low, middle, high), BIK-regions (three groups) and East-West (for the weighting, all respondents living in Berlin received the East German weighting factor). Missing cases were replaced with the mode. The dataset includes six sociodemographic and regional weights: Germany as a whole as well as East and West Germany individually. For each of these regions, two weights were included: one with the transformation weight and one without it.</p>

Usage regulations	<p>Data and documents are released for academic research and teaching: access category A.</p>
Anonymized data	<p>According to German data protection law, only anonymized data can be made accessible for public download. Based on this, some variables had to be deleted from the publicly available dataset. As a matter of course no information is lost. All variables can be used by interested researchers in a Secure Data Center (SDC) at GESIS (Cologne, Mannheim). Some variables are also</p>

Errata

- One respondent (lfdn = 1755) who answered to have taken part in the Bavarian federal state election (q133), was erroneously not shown the question concerning the voting decision (q134aa-bb) and was instead coded to -97 ('not applicable').
