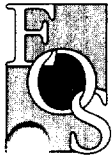


Flash-EB 31 Sep 1994 ZA 2494



DESCRIPTION OF THE SURVEY

This FLASH Survey 31 has been conducted, between the 1th and the 5th of SEPTEMBER 1994 by twelve EOS GALLUP EUROPE Institutes, namely :

Table listing countries and survey details: Belgium (DIMARSO - BRUXELLES), Denmark (GALLUP - KOBENHAVN), Germany (EMNID - BIELEFELD), Greece (ICAP - ATHENS), Spain (DEMOSCOPIA - MADRID), France (GALLUP - PARIS), Ireland (IRISH MKTG SURVEYS - DUBLIN), Italy (DOXA - MILANO), Luxemburg (ILReS - LUXEMBOURG), Netherlands (NIPO - AMSTERDAM), Portugal (NORMA - LISBOA), United Kingdom (NOP - LONDON). Includes interview dates.

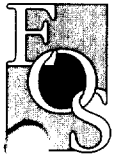
Each national sample is representative of the continental population aged 15 and over, interviewed by telephone, within these limits :

- Greece : the 5 main urban areas
- Ireland : the Dublin area
- Portugal : the 4 main urban areas
- United Kingdom : Nothern Ireland excluded

The sample sizes follow the sizes of the Flash Telephone surveys regularly conducted by EOS GALLUP EUROPE for the European Commission. Hereafter are presented side-by-side :

- the exact size of each sample
- the "Community size", resulting of a weighting factor based on the numeric importance of each population within the Community :
